



## Nature Sights and City Lights Roswell, Georgia

**This tour is available in the spring, summer, and fall months.**

**What to bring: Binoculars, camera, good walking shoes, rain gear, and sunscreen.**

- Arrive evening** Check into Roswell hotel.  
Receive Welcome Bag at check-in (*compliments of Roswell CVB*)  
Dinner at one of Roswell’s many restaurants (*prices vary, determined upon selection*)
- Next Day** Breakfast at hotel (*complimentary with room*)
- 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. Raft or canoe on the gentle Chattahoochee River as it flows through Roswell. You’ll want to keep a journal of the wildlife and wildflowers you see.
- 11:30 – 2:30 p.m. Lunch at the Pavilion at the Chattahoochee Nature Center with a lovely view of the canopy of the surrounding Chattahoochee National Forest. (*Catering prices vary, can be determined upon selection*)  
After lunch, visit the Center where you’ll explore the woodlands, wetlands, and natural science exhibits. (*Admission for groups of 15 or more is \$8 for adults, \$6 for adults over age 65.*) Special programs can be arranged for an additional fee.
- 3:00 – 4:00 p.m. Walking Tour of Roswell’s Historic District. Learn how Roswell King, the founder of Roswell, brought his vision of harnessing water power from the creeks and streams of the Chattahoochee to create a mill village. (*Free app and accompanying map*)
- 4:00 – 5:30 p.m. Hotel/Rest
- 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. Dinner in Roswell (*prices vary, can be determined upon selection*)
- 8:00 – 10:00 p.m. Take the Roswell Ghost Tour. Experience the charm and mystery of the South through ghost stories and learn about Roswell’s deep history. (*Group prices available*)
- Next Day** Breakfast at hotel (*complimentary with room*)
- 10:00 a.m. Hike Vickery Creek Trail by the old mill ruins, cross the Covered Pedestrian Bridge, and explore the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area.
- Noon – 1:30 p.m. Lunch in Roswell’s Historic District. Recognized as a “foodie” destination, Roswell has dozens of restaurants for every taste—barbecue and bistro, tapas and Thai, down-home Southern cooking and continental cuisine. Canton Street, with its period storefronts, art galleries, restaurants and sidewalk cafes, is bustling with vitality, having among its many awards the designation as a *Great Places in Georgia – Great Street*. (*Prices vary, can be determined upon selection*)
- 2:00 p.m. Depart Roswell.
